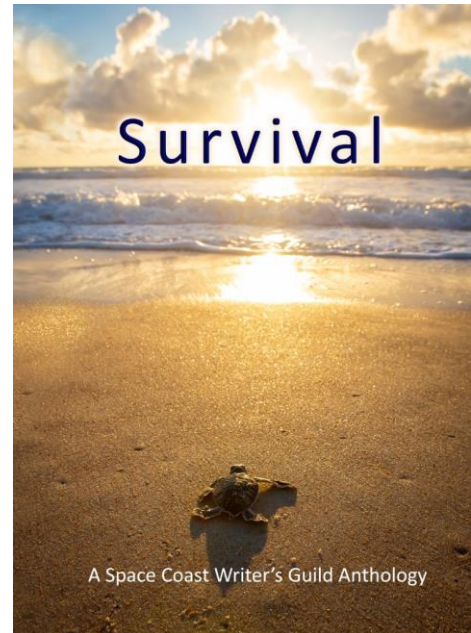
## 2020 SCWG Anthology
