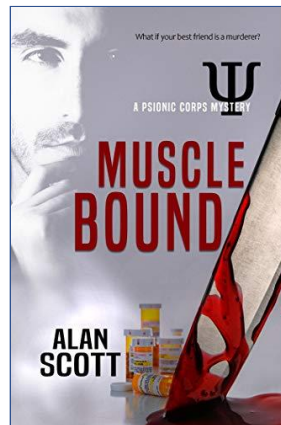
### Guest Speaker:
