<u>Eligibility</u>: The contest is open to active Guild members and nonmembers of all ages.

Submission Guidelines

- Contest opens March 15, 2024.
- Entries must be received no later than midnight on April 15, 2024, by 11:59 pm. Any submission received after the deadline will **NOT** be accepted.
- YOUR NAME MUST NOT BE ON THE STORY MANUSCRIPT.
- The manuscript must be 2500 words or less.
- The document must be typed in Times New Roman, 12 pt. font, double-spaced, and justified with numbered pages.
- The title is to be included on the first page and at the top of each subsequent page.
- Send the story as a PDF file in an e-mail attachment to shortstorycontest@scwg.org. You will receive an acknowledgment.
 - THE BODY OF THE EMAIL SHALL INCLUDE:
 - Your name, phone number, mailing address, email address, title of the story, and word count.
 - Should any of the information above be included in the short story PDF, your entry will be immediately disqualified.

Additional Information

- Genres: General or Literary Fiction, Romance, Historical, Mystery or Suspense, Horror, Science-Based or Alternative.
 - No children's stories, explicit language, or erotica will be accepted.
- Limited to **ONE** (1) submission per person.
- All work must be the original work of the submitting author and must not have been published anywhere (including, but not limited to, any SCWG anthologies or Scribblers of Brevard anthologies) prior to submission. The submitting author retains all rights in his or her submitted work.
- THERE MUST BE NO QUOTES OR SONG LYRICS OR ANY OTHER "BORROWED" MATERIAL WRITTEN BY ANY OTHER AUTHOR, SONG WRITER, ETC.
- All submissions are final. No changes or substitutions are allowed once your entry is submitted.

Judging

A team of readers will complete the first round of selections. Using a **5-point scoring matrix.** The entries will be judged on the following elements:

1 - 5 Points: Structure, Organization, and Pacing1 - 5 Points: Spelling, Punctuation, and Grammar

1 - 5 Points: Plot

1 - 5 Points: Character Appeal and Development

1 - 5 Points: Voice and Writing Style

Using the same scoring matrix, the top 10 final selections will then be reviewed by a panel of four judges

PRIZES

The First Place Winner will receive \$250.00 and a certificate.

The Second Place winner will receive \$150.00 and a certificate.

The Third Place Winner will receive \$100.00 and a certificate.

The Fourth Place winner will receive a gift certificate and a certificate.

The Fifth Place Winner will receive a gift certificate and a certificate.
